Berkshire Bounty happily accepts monetary donations. This allows us to buy cases of fruits, vegetables, eggs, cheese and milk in large quantities for partnering food distribution sites.

Donating money is another way to support this network and invest in community food security. The Giving Back Guide is a good way to get to know the organizations doing this work.
