Berkshire United Way Greylock Society

The Greylock Society celebrates donors who take the lead in supporting our community through Berkshire United Way.

Donors who contribute \$1,000 or more annually are recognized as members of the Greylock Society and are invited to special engagement opportunities with Berkshire United Way. Leadership giving amounts can be met in combination with a partner's donation and contributed through workplace campaign payroll deduction or personal contribution.

Join the Leadership Step-Up Challenge

Through the Leadership Step-Up Challenge, we invite you to increase your impact and receive leadership giving recognition as you do so. The "Step-Up Challenge" encourages donors to increase their giving over a three-year period to achieve a higher leadership level.

How does it work?

You can commit to the challenge starting at any level with the goal to personally give at a Greylock Society or higher level in three years.

Example: Commit to giving at the Peak Greylock Society level

Year 1, give \$500 (\$20 per pay period or only \$10 a week)

Year 2, give \$750 (\$30 per pay period, or only \$15 a week)

Year 3, give \$1,000 (\$40 per bi-weekly pay period, or only \$20 a week)

You will receive recognition and benefits at the Peak Greylock Society level for all three years.

Example: Commit to giving at the Tower Greylock Society level

Year 1, give \$1,000 (\$40 per pay period, or only \$20 a week)

Year 2, give \$2,000 (\$80 per pay period, or only \$40 a week)

Year 3, give \$3,000 (\$120 per pay period, or only \$60 a week)

You will receive recognition and benefits at the Tower Greylock Society level for all three years.
