The Northern Berkshire Community Coalition has been organizing and supporting the Northern Berkshire community since 1986.

Our vision is to be the catalyst for a healthy, empowered, engaged Northern Berkshire community with an emphasis on:

Convening & Connecting Community: We engage residents and stakeholders in community conversations to resolve local concerns. In addition, we connect residents to local service agencies and provide opportunities for social engagement.

A few examples: Monthly community forums, the annual Neighborly Community Recognition Award Celebration, annual MLK Jr. Day of Service, Northern Berkshire HUB Table, Quarterly Stakeholder Breakfasts.

Health and Wellness: We help our community make healthy eating and active living the easy choice, as well as create opportunities for access to health and wellness services.

A few examples: Community Health Work, northern Berkshire Bike Collective, northern Berkshire Fitness Challenge, Summer Neighborhood Basketball, and Working on Wellness (W.o.W.) Workshops.

Leadership Development: We train adults and youth to be leaders within their community and build capacity to make positive change in our region.

A few examples: Community Outreach Volunteer Training, UNO Community Center Steering Committee, Youth Leadership Program, Youth Empowerment Program, Northern Berkshire Youth Collaborative.

Substance Use Prevention: We develop strategies to delay youth alcohol/substance use.

A few examples: Prevention Needs Assessment, annual 413 Youth Conference, New Hampshire Teen Institute Partnership, Guiding Good Choices.

Family Support and Education: We provide families within our community with the resources, activities, and group support needed to maintain a strong and resilient family. In addition, we provide workshops and classes for all parents to develop stronger skills to become the best parent they can be for their children.

A few examples: 1:1 Meetings at Schools, IEP & 504 Plan Organizing Support, Parenting Support Groups & Workshops, annual Backpacked for Success event, facilitating DCF Visitations, 1:1 Parenting Support at Home/Office, Family & Neighborhood Events.

Youth Development: We actively build a positive youth development culture by encouraging youth to grow and realize their full potential. In addition, we also support those who work with youth through networking and training efforts.
